Super Singles Competition

Super Singles offered at 3 levels

- Ribbons and prizes awarded for 1st to 4th place
- Ducks to be used for Advanced & Hunter, pigeons for puppies
- \$20.00 entry fee per dog with multiple entries allowed
- Sign up the morning of the event between 8:00 am and 9:00 am

Super Singles Competition

- ❖ Divisions consist of 3-4 **SINGLE MARKS** per dog scored from **1-10**
- ❖ **IF your dog is handled, they are eliminated from the competition**
- ❖ All dogs run MARKS under one set of judges
- ❖ **3 DIVISIONS**
 - PUPPY** – A dog 5 months of age to 1 year of age **WITH NO** JH title or SH or MH passes or equivalent HRC or NAHRA titles
 - HUNTER** – A dog 5 months of age or older **WITH NO** SH TITLE or MH passes or equivalent HRC or NAHRA titles.
 - ADVANCED** – A dog 5 months of age or older **WITH** a SH TITLE or MH passes or equivalent HRC or NAHRA titles or higher
- ❖ \$20.00 entry fee per dog per division, dogs may run in multiple divisions
- ❖ Please no bitches in season, this event is open to all breeds 5 months or older



Super Singles Competition Rules

1. Dogs may run only once per division
2. Handlers may enter multiple dogs
3. If a dog handles they will be eliminated from the competition
4. In Advanced or Hunter, white coat or hunt test gunners can be used, along with hidden guns' this is the judge's choice. Puppies will be white coat only.
5. All marks will be on land
6. Duck call, shot and throw for puppy division
7. Shot and Throw for Hunters and Advanced division
8. Marks must be delivered back to the line
9. No talking to the dog after the mark is called for
10. Dogs will be released by the judges
11. Controlled breaks will be allowed
12. No re-lining of the dog after the Mark is thrown
13. PUPPY & HUNTER DIVISION dogs may be gentle restrained
14. ADVANCED DIVISION dogs must be steady
15. In case of a tie in the advanced division a blind may be run
16. In case of a tie in the puppy & hunter division a run off would take place
17. Judges decisions are final
18. A ribbon ceremony will be held after all division are finished
