Good Day CMRC Members!

We are winding down a very busy month of June and heading right into another busy month of July. The fun just never ends! Personally, I've been on the road a bit and have spent more nights in my camper than in my home. And that's ok by me!

We hosted a fantastic AKC Hunt Test June 16-18. Test Chair Dan Tongen and the crew did a great job handling nearly 200 entries over the course of three days. THANK YOU to all the club members that so willingly gave their time over the three days to support the event. The event ran smoothly and was once again very profitable.

The club house remodeling project is going in earnest now. Perhaps you've seen the photos I posted on our Facebook page with all the walls torn off the frame of the building. There's no turning back now.

The past number of years Pat has been doing seminars training the trainers. He has terrific communication skills and is a great facilitator.
