President Mike Gohman called the March 1, 2011 meeting to order. Officers present were Mike, Roger Weller & Paul Hanson. Board members present were Tom Torvik, Mark Belford, Mike Nugent and Gordie Schlichting. Also present were Rick Anderson, Dan Hills, Jim Stang, Dan Stavrum, Chad Sweep and Bruce Zieglmeier.

A breakdown of our financial reports indicated that the Informal Trial income is down due to cancellations of the December and January trials due to weather. More membership dues have been paid to date as compared to last year. The Club Banquet income was down partly in part to fewer members attending. Equipment and Grounds maintenance is up due to the increased

snow removal. (Will spring ever get here?) A donated lay-out blind will be auctioned off at the June Hunting Test. Deposits have been made to Dan Sayles for the Field Trial and Hunting Test birds. The Judges gifts for the Spring Field Trial have been purchased.

The cost of birds for the trials and hunting tests have gone up as well as the costs of other expense such as food costs and bird thrower expenses. With this in mind, it was voted to raise the entry fees for the Spring Trial to \$80 for the Open All-Age and \$75 for the Derby, Qualifying and Amateur. The entry fees for the Hunting Test was raised by \$5 across the board to \$70 for the Master, \$65 for the Senior and \$60 for the Junior stakes.

CMRC will be renting the grounds to the Flat Coat Specialty Club for a fee of \$275 per day which is the rental rate charged to Professional Trainers for the day.

A discussion was held regarding the Bird Throwers and Field help at both the Informal Trials as well as the licensed Trials and Hunting Tests. Currently CMRC pays \$50 per day for Popper/Throwers at the Informals and compensation for blind planters and line workers being discretionary and performance based. CMRC pays \$75 per day for Youth Field workers who are a minimum of 16 years of age and hold a valid Firearms Safety Training Certificate. Compensation for blind planters and line workers is discretionary and performance based.

A Spring Work weekend has been planned for Saturday April 30th and Sunday May 1st. Please mark your calendar and plan to attend and help out.

The annual shot clinic for CMRC will be held on May 3, 2011 to coincide with our May meeting. Dr. Dennis Nelson will be presiding over the event which will begin at 3:00 pm. The clinic is open to ALL dogs.
