Treasurer Paul Hanson reported that the Informals are netting approximately \$1000 per trial which should bring in \$5000 for the year. Income from the club banquet was up \$1000 from last year. Real estate taxes in the amount of \$6,248 have been paid for 2012. Members are encouraged to contact Duane Smith to pick up their book of raffle tickets for the spring trial. The sale of these tickets is a part of the fund raising that the club does to support the club.

The event committee of Paul Hanson and Duane Smith are exploring the option of having an outdoor dog event using Steve Esping as a resource.

Mark Belford, as field trial chairman, reported that things are going well. Chris Brandl has stepped up to judge the Amateur in the Fall with Roz Wilson. The Spring trial is waiting for a new judge to complete her judging test for AKC before it can be opened up for entries on Entry Express.

Gordie Schlichting with the Hunting Test reported that things are going well. John Blackbird will have the event on Entry Express soon. The entry fees are \$75, \$70 and \$65. Tom Torvik spoke up saying that CMRC is a business and should be charging the same for Master and Open dogs. We need to generate revenue from all facets to support the club.

Mike Nugent reported that the club is waiting for the mud to dry up before beginning repairs on the culverts. The spring clean up days are on April 21 & 22, 2012. Club members are urged to mark their calendars to come and help with the clean up of grounds and buildings.

Gordie Schlichting reported that the response to the Youth Handling Clinic has been lower than was hoped. He will be sending out another invitation to the youth to sign up and join in the activities of the day. Anyone interested should call Gordie to sign up.

The Minnesota Masters event will be held on September 15, 2012 at Kettle River by Hinkley. CMRC is seeking a couple of volunteers to help staff the event.

The shot clinic for CMRC has been scheduled for May 1, 2012 starting at 3:00 pm. This event is open to all dogs and Doc Dennis Nelson is very generous to the club as he donates a major portion of his profits back to CMRC. An example of the prices for the event from 2011 were: DHLPP - \$15, Lymes - \$16, Rabies - \$15, Heartworm Test \$16. I do not have the price for Bordetella or for the Ivomec heartworm medicine. This is a liquid that Doc Nelson dispenses at a fraction of the cost of a product such as Heartguard. There is no office charge for the vaccinations nor does Doc Nelson do a complete physical on the dogs.

The club house has been established as a Smoke Free Building. Everyone is reminded to not smoke inside the building.
