The annual shot clinic will be held on Wednesday May 9th starting at 3 pm and followed by the club meeting at 7 pm. CMRC Life Member, Doc Dennis Nelson is very generous with the club. Tick season is fast approaching. Blacklegged or deer ticks carry seven different disease agents of which Lyme disease is the most prevalent. More than a third of adult blacklegged or deer ticks carry Lyme disease. Local ticks include brown dog ticks, wood ticks and lone star ticks for a few.

Permethrin, an insecticide meant for application to outerwear, and DEET are good deterrents to ticks. Symptoms of Lyme's disease include rash, muscle aches, joint pain, excess fatigue or other changes in one's health. The top seven tick related diseases are: Lyme, Anaplasmosis (dog fever), Ehrlichiosis, Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, Hepatazoonosis, Babesiosis and Bartonellosis.

Protect yourself and protect your dogs. Talk to your vet about what is the best for the dogs: topical solutions, collars, shots or monthly or quarterly tablets. Some dogs are allergic to topical solutions; collars lose their effectiveness swimming; not every dog can use the chewable tablets. Be smart and talk to your vet. Daily protection is the answer.
